PICK-A-PRO RULES

You will draw 3 players from the TOP 20 that made the cut from each of the 4 Majors, thus giving you a "foursome."

We will pair **their Sunday 18-hole scores** with your 18 hole NET and GROSS score giving you a "foursome total."

- You can play either or both days. Saturday or Sunday
- (*If you play both days, only your best score will count)
- You must have a GHIN HDCP to be eligible to win in the NET portion.
- 100% of your COURSE HANDICAP is used.
- We will use the "Shots Off Calculation" if anyone that participates with a (+) HDCP.
- Open to Men and Women and Guests.

Senior Tee's will *Note-There could be times when a "Pro" Golfer is on multiple teams as each time a "foursome" is drawn, all players go back in the hat.
