

#### CCC Board Meeting – Monday, September 21, 2021

Board Members Present:

#### Minutes from the August Board Meeting were approved.

#### Financial Report: David McIlvain

- Cart Rental is down vs last year mostly due to prepaid cart cards sold last December which inflated 2020.
- Balance Sheet shows current assets at \$92,651 vs \$27,017 last year.
- P&L shows a positive YTD of \$70,281 vs \$26,149 last year.
- The Financial Report was approved.

#### Staff Report: Grant Howard

- Greens will be plugged on Monday, September 27th
- Discussed purchasing 10 sprinkler heads. (MGA to purchase)
- Discussed going to Danville and Winchester Country Clubs once their Bermuda goes dormant to see if we would like to overseed with bluegrass in our fairways next fall.

#### Pro Shop Report: Jim Fuller

- Friday night Par 3's are still attracting approx. 20 players.
- Discussed opening to the public as we have in the past October-February. (No action taken)

#### Old Business

- Barn Repair
  - Motion made by Ray Huellemeier and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Shain Stephens to approve \$775 for Jake Dennison to repair boards on the barn. Motion carried
  - Motion made by Shain Stephens and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ray Huellemeier to approve \$850 for Joey Franklin to paint the barn roof.
  - Carl Nunnelley had received a bid of \$3000 from Joey Franklin to paint the roof and barn. The Board approved the roof portion and asked Carl to get estimates on metal siding versus the paint before moving forward.
  - Discussed getting bids/estimates on cart path repairs. (Carl Nunnelley to head up)

#### New Business:

- Treasurer for 2021
  - David McIlvain has made it known that he wants to leave the position at the end of the year. Lynn
    Northcutt was approached and agreed to handle the financial reports, paying bills and handling payroll.
