- **The Baby Pool is now closed PERMANENTLY, it will be removed from the premises soon. It has been deemed unsafe and unable to be repaired.**
- Rules for Guests: You may bring the same guest (if they live in the Harrison County/Cynthiana area, three (3) times per season, for \$5 each. If they are an out of town guest, you may bring them an unlimited amount of times for \$7 each.
- Grandparents who are members may bring their grandchildren.
- No one under the age of 12 may come to the pool without the supervision of an adult.
- Babysitters may bring children of members.
- **All attendees of the pool MUST sign in at the Pro-Shop before swimming , daily.**
- If there is no lifeguard on duty, or the lifeguard is on a break, you may **SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK. In AUGUST, there will be SEVERAL times when this is the case.**
- No Smoking inside the fence around the pool area. You may smoke in the parking lot.
- There will be no more pool parties scheduled for the year as most of the guards are going back to college and others have high school sports and activities.
