13U: Must be no older than 13 years old.

Minimum age here at Stoughton CC is 6 years old.

17U: Participants between the age of 14-17.

It’s a two-player pairs, match play scramble format from appropriate tees.

Every 3 holes (1-3, 4-6-7-9) is worth a point or flag. Teams with the most points win the match. U13 9 holes, U17 18 holes.

We’re looking for kids interested in joining the team for next year by participating in some Junior golf instruction and course play. We will model the time to simulate a match, work on swing fundamentals and learn the rules of golf.
