Finance and Long-range Planning Committee

The Finance and LRP Committee has been working on two main projects; the 2021 Operating budget and the Reserve Study to plan repairs and replacements for our community over the next 30 years. The 2021 Operating budget has been submitted to the Board for approval and will be available for community review prior to our Annual Meeting. Camaloch has purchased software to complete our

Reserve Study and the committee has entered over 120 components (items that require repair and/or replacement). Special meetings with the community will be set up to explain how the Reserve Study Software works and the information it can provide for our financial decision making.
