Pool Updates

When the Camano Island weather goes into triple digits aren't you glad that you live in a community with two pools!

Here are a few updates about our Pools:

- 1. The heater at Pool 2 has failed and will need to be replaced. The parts for this repair are currently out of stock. Unfortunately, it appears that Pool 2 will be without a heater for the remainder of the summer.
- 2. We will be moving the Adult Swim hour at 11am to Pool 1.
- 3. Pools are for association members only. The guests of an association member is welcome to use the pool only if the member is present at the pool with them.
- 4. We are limited to how many keys that we can program into our pool card readers at the pools. Because of this, we need to limit members to ONE KEY PER HOUSEHOLD. If you need a second key because you have lost your first, we will deactivate your old key when we give you your new one.
- 5. The new pool furniture has been delayed. Even though it was ordered months ago, we have been told that our pool furniture shipment has been delayed again. Covid labor and shipping



delays have made this a longer process that we had hoped.

6. The pump at Pool 1 has been replaced. We are also fixing the railing at Pool 1 and the ladder in Pool 2.

Water Team Update

As many of you are aware, Camaloch has been working to update our community water system. Because of the skyrocketing costs of labor and materials, the bids that we received in June for the construction of our new Pumphouse were far greater in cost than what was originally approved in our Construction Ioan for Phase 1. We have formed a Water Team

comprised of current and former board members as well as association members who relevant experience. Members of our water team have met with the State Department of Health, Coffman Engineering, and King Water to decide the appropriate next steps. The Water Team has recommended that the Camaloch board pause current work by our Engineers, while we weigh our options moving forward.

The board plans to host a special informational meeting as soon as the Water Team completes their assessment of the situation. The current Bid Packets for Phase 1 and 2 can be found on our website <u>by clicking here.</u>
