
Fishing Derby Saturday April 17th at 8AM

Camaloch Permits – YOU NEED TO KNOW

This is a very important reminder! If you are doing any construction or having anyone do any construction on your property, you will need a permit.

If you are having any work done to the right of way in front of your home, even if the work is being done by contractors or utility companies, you will need a permit.



We recently noted a utility company that was doing some work in the right-of-way to install utility services for a member. The contractor that the utility company used did not use Camaloch approved materials to repair the hole that they had to dig in our right-of-way. This was reported to the Association Office by an association member. Unfortunately, when any contractor, or utility company is doing work on behalf of an association member, the association member is responsible for any damage, mess, or incomplete work left in our right-of-way.

Our website contains copies or our Work Permit, our Right-of-Way Permit, as well as specifications for any work being done in the Camaloch Right-of-Way. You can find permits on our website at https://camalochgolf.com/camaloch-hoa-information/

If you are in doubt as to whether or not you will need a permit for any work being done, please feel free to contact the Association Office at 360-387-6794. When you submit a permit, our Architecture and Roads Committee is normally able to give you approval within 1-2 business days.

Emergency Preparedness for Camaloch neighbors
Whether or not you have been in Camaloch this winter,
you're aware that (and personal) community emergencies
happen. This winter as a community we have encountered
power outages, snow and high winds. You or a neighbor may



have experienced an emergency medical situation. And we've all heard that a big earthquake in Puget Sound is a question of when, not if.

The Camaloch Board is committed to keeping our neighborhood safe and encourages everyone to get prepared. We'll provide helpful information on a regular basis via this newsletter and on the website.

There are several ways to prepare as a household and as a community, and here are some steps.

For your household, you should think about what you need when the power goes out, for a few hours or possibly much longer. Both FEMA (<u>www.ready.gov</u>) and the <u>Red Cross</u> provide lots of helpful information about building an emergency kit and plan.

From a neighborhood standpoint, a great first step is training in Community Emergency



Response Teams (CERT). The CERT program educates people about disaster preparedness for hazards (e.g., fire, flood, power outage) that may impact their area and trains them in basic disaster response skills, such as fire safety, light search and rescue, team organization, and disaster medical operations. Other topics include putting

together your own disaster kit, disaster psychology and disaster incident management. Several Camaloch residents are already trained in CERT and we'd like to get enough interested residents to have a dedicated Camaloch training group.
